

7 KEYS TO LEARNING AT HOME

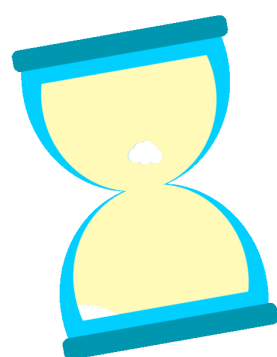


CREATE A LEARNING TOOLBOX

Use tools like clipboards and kitchen timers to create flexible learning environments that enhance productivity.

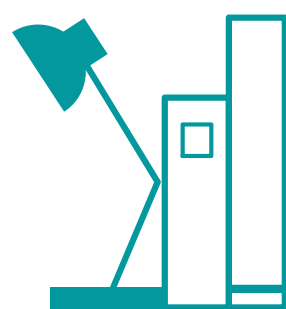


INCORPORATE BREAKS

Implement 15 minute breaks for every 45 minutes of schoolwork. Getting them away from the screen will increase energy and focus when schoolwork resumes.

CREATE THE RIGHT LEARNING SPACE

Quiet spaces foster effective learning. Designate between learning and home environments by keeping your home quiet during learning hours.



ESTABLISH A ROUTINE

Children flourish in structured, stable environments. Set aside the same general time each day for schoolwork and stick to it!

ASK QUESTIONS

GIVE THEM CHOICES
